

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF REHOBOTH

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Arkansas, relating to benevolent, religious, educational, and miscellaneous associations, have entered into and do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation is **REHOBOTH**, the "Corporation.")

ARTICLE II

Location

The principal office and location of the Corporation is.

ARTICLE III

Duration of Corporation

The Corporation shall continue in perpetual succession unless and until dissolved in the manner set forth in Article VI of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE IV

Purposes

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (the "Code"), and more specifically:

A. Religious charitable and benevolent and educational, and especially to conduct religious services and activities according to the rules, regulations, usages and discipline of the Association of Kingsway Fellowship International, a non-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Iowa, with headquarters located at 3707 SW 9th Street Des Moines Iowa 50315; and to cultivate social interaction among its members and to assist in improving the moral and spiritual conditions of humanity.

B. To purchase, sell and publish such literature, including magazines, pamphlets, and books as in the opinion of the Board of Directors and the Minister would be for the furtherance of its purposes and causes and which would meet with the approval of the directors of Rehoboth.

C. To receive love offerings and contributions, to receive, manage, take and hold real, personal property by gift, grant, or bequest, and to sell or dispose of the same for the benefit of this Corporation.

D. To purchase or sell, hypothecate, mortgage, and lease such real and personal property as may be necessary for the purpose of the Corporation, and to execute deeds, contracts, agreements and obligations, the purposes whereof are consonant with the laws of the State of Arkansas under which this Corporation is formed, and to accept and execute any trust; the purpose whereof is lawful under said laws and consistent with the purposes of this Corporation; and to do each and everything necessary, suitable, or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes herein enumerated, or which may at any time appear conducive or expedient for the benefit or protection of this Corporation.

E. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any members, officer, director, or incorporator of the Corporation, but the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its purposes

F. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall have all the powers to carry out any and all activities in furtherance of any purpose for which a corporation may be organized, except to the extent that any power or purpose would not be permitted to be carried on:

(1) by an organization exempt from Federal Income Taxation under Section 501 (a) of the Code, or the corresponding provision of any future Federal Income Tax law, by reason of being described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Code;

(2) By a corporation, contributions to which are authorized deductible under Section 170(a) of the Code by reason of such corporation being described in Section 170 (c) (2) of the Code.

ARTICLE V

Management

B. The management of the affairs of this Corporation shall be governed by such bylaws as the Minister and the Board of Directors may from time to time adopt. Any proposed amendment shall be subject to ratification by the membership.

ARTICLE VI

Dissolution

Should this corporation dissolve!

a) All property and funds remaining after the payment of the debts of the corporation shall be delivered to local non-profit corporations organized under the laws of the State of Arkansas, for religious and educational purposes.

b) Such funds or property shall be for the use and benefit of the Association as may be determined by the Board of Trustees, in alignment with current policies and procedures.
